Dear Residents and Families of The Cardinal,

This week North Carolina's positivity rate is much lower than previous weeks with 7.7% positivity as of this afternoon. Approximately 4,765 new COVID-19 cases were reported today and 2,943 people are hospitalized across the state. As a reminder, we ask residents to continue to be vigilant in their safety awareness as it relates to COVID-19 and to continue to get tested weekly in the Art Studio even though numbers are finally trending down.

Residents who signed up to receive their flu vaccine at The Cardinal on Wednesday, October 6th should have received a flyer in their in-house cubbie on Friday with the appointment time. If you have not signed up yet and would like to receive your flu shot on Wednesday, please call or stop by the front desk to be placed on the list and to receive an appointment time. Hayes Barton Pharmacy will be here from 10:00am – 2:00pm and the clinic will take place in the Family Room on the second floor of the Clubhouse.

You will need to complete a flu vaccination consent form prior to the clinic. This consent form is available at the front desk for residents to complete prior to Wednesday. Residents will need to bring their Medicare/Insurance card with them to the clinic on October 6th.

The Resident Advisory Board is seeking new members for next year and the election process is underway. Residents received ballots in their cubbie last week for the resident candidates who are running this year. A ballot box is located at the IL front desk for all completed ballots. The deadline for submitting your ballot is Friday, October 8th.

Marshmon Car Detailing will be at The Cardinal on Sunday, October 3rd from 8:00am – 1:00pm. If you are interested in having your car detailed this Sunday, please call or stop by the front desk to reserve your spot.

The City of Raleigh is planning improvements soon on Six Forks Road between Rowan Street and Lynn Road and they are hosting a Virtual Open House to share details with residents and answer questions during a live Q&A online.
